**Mitigation Strategy Policies**

1. Universal and correct wearing of masks
  - a. Guidance by the local public health authority (LPHA) Livingston County Health Center
  - b. Masks allowed
2. Physical Distancing
  - a. Students in cohorts with distancing
3. Handwashing and respiratory etiquette
  - a. Taught and reinforced
  - b. Hand sanitizer provided
4. Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation
  - a. Increased cleaning for high-touch services
  - b. Update existing systems
5. Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the State, local, territorial, or Tribal health departments
  - a. Contract tracing by LEA
  - b. Contract tracing by the local public health authority (LPHA) Livingston County Health Center
6. Diagnostic and screening testing
  - a. Testing available at the local public health authority (LPHA) Livingston County Health Center
7. Efforts to provide vaccinations to educators, other staff, and students if eligible
  - a. LEA participates in vaccination events
8. Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to the health and safety policies
  - a. Accommodations as necessary or as mandated by Individual Education Plan

**Continuity of Services**
